



Clubhouse FOB Guidelines

The following Members are eligible for a clubhouse FOB:

All Club Directors

Any elected position. (President, Vice-President, Secretary, Treasurer, or Trustee.)

Any committee Chairman appointed by the club President.

Hunter Trapper Education Instructors

Life Members

Any Adult Member who has attended 3 or more monthly meetings and performed 10 hours of verifiable work within a calendar year. (Work hours required is reduced to 6 after the first year.)

Verifiable Work Hours for Club Members include, but are not limited to:

Attend weekly club workday.

Grass mowing, tree trimming, debris cleanup, etc.

Maintenance to club grounds; litter cleanup, road repairs, range repairs, maintenance of trails, pond, etc.

Maintenance to club buildings; painting, cleaning rest rooms, cleaning kitchen, cleaning main meeting room, cleaning downstairs meeting room, cleaning up garage areas, etc.

Volunteer at any Club sponsored event.

**Work hours must be submitted to the Membership Chair, Officer or Trustee.
The cost of the FOB is the responsibility of the member.**

**Report any damage or issues immediately to any club Officer or Trustee.
Exceptions may be granted for club sponsored events.**
